

Organiser fitting guide.

Pictures below show how the trays must be installed into the box to allow everything to fit.



The picture above shows the player mats in place with the trick reference booklets, then the shallow token tray fits at the end of the booklets with the two token pots sitting on top. The first L shaped tray sits through the middle on top of the square cards. Now you can fit the two trays of cards, one of which spans over the exposed corner of the player cards. The other tray of cards fits into the empty corner abutting the L shaped tray. Now fit the second L shaped tray and finally the four player counter trays. Finally the remaining info sheets and booklets go on top. If the game is likely to be transported and the box shaken, a small sheet of foam cut to fit over the coloured counter trays to stop the round pegs from rolling about is a good idea.
